How does Union with Christ affect "Who I am"?



Problems with "Choose Your Own Identity" Approach:

- 1. Accent on unlimited freedom often leads to paralysis
- 2. Leads to anxiety
- 3. Having more choices makes us discontent
- 4. The freedom enthroning narrative of "Choose Your Own Identity" ends up robbing us of the very freedom it promises
- 5. This mindset negatively affects how we view God

Contrast: Union with Christ

- 1. Union with Christ gives us permission to rest
- 2. We are enabled to truly be content in all circumstances
- 3. We are enabled to be content in all circumstances
- 4. We are most free when we have the right boundaries
- God is closer and more intimate than we ever imagined

Let's Get Practical...

- Who am I in Christ?
 - I am loved (1 John 4:10)
 - I am free (Gal 5:1)
 - I am a child of God (John 1:12)
 - I am a new creation (2 Cor 5:17)
 - Etc.
- Why do we have trouble getting these concepts to stick?

- Bible's metaphors: adoption and marriage
 - Both have a legal and relational aspect to them
