## SO [THEREFORE]

- Chapter 1
  - Paul's affectionate heart & joyful prayer for Philippians
  - Paul's joy in the advance of the gospel
  - Paul's joyful hope, life or death
  - "Only let your manner of life be worthy of the gospel..."
    - "with one mind striving side by side for the faith of the gospel"
    - "not frightened by opponents"
    - "granted to you..." to "suffer for his sake"

- Verse 1 Disclaimer:
  - Not 100% sure of precise details
  - Commentaries disagree
  - Will offer multiple possibilities
  - Will show you where I landed
  - Maybe vague on purpose?
- Big picture IS clear:
  - Paul is giving 4 reasons to have unity in the church

- Any encouragement in Christ,
  - Exhortation?
- Any comfort from love,
  - Whose love?
- Any participation in the Spirit,
- Any affection and sympathy...

<sup>3</sup> I thank my God in all my remembrance of you, <sup>4</sup> always in every prayer of mine for you all making my prayer with joy, 5 because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now. <sup>6</sup> And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ. 7 It is right for me to feel this way about you all, because I hold you in my heart, for you are all partakers with me of grace, d both in my imprisonment and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel. <sup>8</sup> For God is my witness, how I yearn for you all with the affection of Christ Jesus.

#### IN OTHER WORDS

 You have good reason to be encouraged in Christ, so focus on that rather than being unhappy about the little things that drive you apart...

 If I have comforted you by loving you with the love of Christ, then return the favor to me...

If you are really joined as one body through the Spirit...

• If you care about me (deep down in your bowels)...

#### ...COMPLETE MY JOY

- Implication:
  - Paul's joy currently incomplete, but almost complete
  - Consider Paul's circumstances
  - What does this tell us about Paul's joy?

- Being of the same mind
- Having the same love
- Being in full accord
- And [being] of one mind

Noun

- Being of the same mind
- Having the same love
- Being in full accord
- And [being] of one mind

State of being (not an action)

"Unity" adjective

- Emphasis Unity, Unity, Unity, Unity!
- It's about true unity of being
  - Not (just) outward actions that appear unified

- Same mind
  - What should the "same mind" be set on?
- Same love
  - What is the "same love" for?
- Full accord
  - What does full accord look like?

#### DO NOTHING OUT OF

- Selfish ambition
  - "Factions" or Partisanship
  - Literally what a Greek politician does to get elected
  - Leading/developing a faction to get a position of power and respect
- Conceit
  - Empty Pride, not based on truth
  - What is the truth about ourselves?

#### HUMILITY

- Humility
  - What does our culture say about pride?
  - What does our culture say about humility?
  - Direct contrast with "conceit"
- Count others more significant
  - Esteem or honor
  - Direct contrast with "selfish ambition"
  - It should be ok to not be in charge or recognized

#### **INTERESTS**

- Looking to own interests assumed
  - Not condemned
- Must also look to the interests of others
- Mark 12:31 "The second is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."

#### FOR THOUGHT

 How well does Paul's description of Christian unity describe your heart?

 Where is the source of your joy? Are you relying on something to bring joy that ultimately can't do that?

 Are there any actions or attitudes that you (we?) need to repent of?
